



Workshop and discussion on possible development of Limbazi green energy region

On Wednesday, January 19, 2011, a workshop and discussion about development of Limbazi renewable energy region (the territory of former Limbazi district) will be organized by "Ekodoma", Ltd. and district municipalities of Limbazi and Salacgriva. The workshop is promoted by programme Intelligent Energy Europe within the framework of Bioregions project (IEE/09/769/SI2.558258).

The aim of the workshop is to highlight benefits of production and use of renewable energy to regional employers, industries of wood-processing and logging, agriculture, tourism, local municipalities, public organizations, and every resident. Participants of the workshop will include speakers from Finland, who will share their knowledge on development of bio-regions in Finland and on the benefits it gives to all involved parties.

According to the definition of BioRegions project, the aim of a green energy region or bio-region is to maintain at least one third of its energy needs (excluding transport sector) from regional and sustainable bioenergy sources, with main focus on solid biomass.

Employers from Limbazi, Salacgriva and Aloja regions, also representatives of public organizations and tourism industry, producers and users of biofuel and other concerned persons are kindly welcome to participate in the workshop. Two workshops will be held in total: first one in the Salacgriva House of Culture from 9 to 12 am and the second one – in the building of Limbazi district municipality (Rigas Str.16) from 2 to 5 pm.
